Did you know that...

- CKEditor is **customizable**. You can fine-tune the set of enabled plugins, available toolbar buttons, and the behavior of features.
- The editor supports **@mentions**. Start typing `@An` to see available suggestions.
- You can also insert dynamic placeholders within the content using **merge fields**! Start typing `{} or use the {:} button to insert them.` Use the `{:}` button to preview values. `{}Merge Field Example`
- You can **paste content** from Word or Google Docs, retaining the original document structure and formatting.
- Thanks to Import from Word , you can **convert** a DOCX document into HTML and edit it in CKEditor 5.
- You can **export your document** to PDF  or Word  with a single click.
- This demo showcases **CKBox**  to **manage images and other files**. You can enable your own upload adapter instead.

Autoformatting in CKEditor 5

Some features of CKEditor 5 might be hard to spot at first glance. Thanks to **autoformatting**, you can use handy shortcuts in the editor to format the text on the fly:

Block formatting	Bulleted list	Start a line with <code>*</code> or <code>-</code> followed by a space.
	Numbered list	Start a line with <code>1.</code> or <code>1)</code> followed by a space.
	To-do list	Start a line with <code>[]</code> or <code>[x]</code> followed by a space to insert an unchecked or checked list item.
	Headings	Start a line with <code>#, ##, or ###</code> followed by a space to create a heading 1, heading 2, or heading 3.
	Block quote	Start a line with <code>></code> followed by a space.
	Code block	Start a line with <code>```</code> .
	Horizontal line	Start a line with <code>---</code> .
Inline formatting	Bold	Type <code>**</code> or <code><u> </u></code> around your text.
	<i>Italic</i>	Type <code>*</code> or <code><u> </u></code> around your text.
	<code>Code</code>	Type <code>`</code> around your text.
	Strikethrough	Type <code>~~</code> around your text.
